I am requesting funding for the Washington State Hospital Association Rural Hospitals Birthing/Maternity Training & Capacity Expansion project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Washington State Hospital Association.

The funding would be used to provide technical assistance, training, and simulations that are in line with recommendations from the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) to 30 critical access hospitals (CAH) that have delivery services and 14 without delivery services (ED training) most of which are also critical access hospitals. All 43 hospitals are in rural, underserved areas. The Washington State Hospital Association will support these hospitals with training and virtual simulation.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 2331 of the Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990, 7 U.S. Code section 950aaa.
