Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Snoqualmie Tribe Police Station - Snoqualmie Indian Tribe, WA project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe, located at 9571 Ethan Wade Way SE, Snoqualmie, WA 98065.

The funding would be used to update the Snoqualmie Tribe Police Station to grow their capacity to serve the tribal people, businesses, and greater community. Upgrades to the existing 20-plus-year-old modular units would include the construction of storage for safety equipment, police gear, and additional surveillance. The current evidence room is a closet. The project also includes infrastructure updates, such as rebuilding the entrance to be ADA-compliant. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because upgrades would help the Snoqualmie Tribe Police Station assist local and county law enforcement, including working with the King County Sheriff's office to cross-deputize tribal police. Improvements would also allow the tribal police to hold evidence or drugs in a secure place during criminal investigations. This investment will enhance emergency response across King County, Interstate 90, and the central Cascades.

This project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
